2005 – 2009

Development of the Croatian National Education Standard (CNES/HNOS) for elementary (primary and lower secondary) school was finalized in 2005.

The HRV-InSEA members (12) were involved into this project of the Ministry of Science, Education and Sports, as the members of 1) the Committee for the Development of the National Visual Arts Education Standard (3 members: prof. Vera Turkovic, Ana Novoselac, and Vladimira Bosnjak; Coordinator was: prof. E. R. Tanay), 2) the Committee for the Revision of the National Visual Arts Education Standard for "elementary" school (Grade 1–8) (9 members: Ivan Bogavcic, prof. Marcel Bacic, Miroslav Huzjak, Ida Mati, prof. Vera Kos Paliska, Dubravka Kuscevic, prof. Stjepko Rupcic, Ana Sobat, Mirjana Tomasevic; Coordinator: Miroslav Huzjak), establishing the Croatian National Education Standards for primary and lower secondary school.

During the academic year 2005/06, the elements of the CNES were experimentally introduced in 5% of "elementary" (Grade 1–8) schools in the Republic of Croatia.

The "National Curriculum"/ P i P, based on the CNES, was established at the end of the academic year 2005/06.

The HRV-InSEA members (2) were involved into this project (M. Huzjak, M. Tomasevic; Coordinators: Prof. E. R. Tanay, M. Tomasevic for Grade 5–8, M. Huzjak for Grade 1–4)

During the academic year 2006/07, all "elementary" (primary and lower secondary) schools started implementing the CNES and the "National Curriculum".

The project Opening the windows and doors of our city (Zagreb, December 2008 – May 2009) had the main goal to point out the importance of Visual Arts in education and prevention of aggressive behaviour in children. The participants were the teachers: Tatjana Kovačić (S. S. Kranjčević School), Ana Novoselac (A. G. Matoš School), Vladimira Bošnjak (Stenjevec School), Milena Matijević Medvešek (Trnsko School), and Damir Aljinović (Ivan Gundulić School) & their pupils, 10 – 15 ys old.

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In November 2005 M. Tomašević Dančević, the president of the **HRV-InSEA**, was appointed Senior Adviser for Visual Arts at the Institute of Education of the Republic of Croatia, in Zagreb.
